The Village of Kingston is seeking an individual for the position of Recreation Program Leader. Under the direction of the Recreation Coordinator, the successful applicant will be responsible for but not limited to the planning and operation of the Kingston summer day camp for children aged 5-12 and also the overall supervision of the Summer Day Camp Staff. This temporary, full-time position is expected to start Tuesday May 21st, 2019 and run until Friday August 23rd, 2019.
