Dear Facility Users,

The arena managers of the three above mentioned facilities would like to inform the users of our facilities the facilities rules around COVID-19 contract tracing.

It will be the responsibilities of the users to take record of all people included in a rental that are entering and exiting the buildings. Below are examples but not limiting to whom must be on the contact lists as ALL PERSONS ARE TO BE ACCOUNTED FOR. A safety administrative person for the sessions must be located at or near the front entrances to account for their rental.

- Players
- Coaches & Bench Staff
- Officials
- Parents
- Spectators

The facilities have a lot of monies invested in making and preparing the ice surfaces for the players and as per PUBLIC HEALTH all people entering a facility must be accounted for.

As we know you are all wanting a long and successful recreational season as are we, therefore the above mentioned is 100% mandatory with no exceptions.

In the event there are overlapping sessions (example games or practices) the information for both sessions will be forwarded to public health in the event of a possible exposure to COVID-19.

Your attention to this matter is greatly appreciated, in the event it is not followed the facilities hold the right to limit an access to people that are not being tracked as part of the session. No facility wants to eliminate spectators so please adhere to the above-mentioned facility request.
