

Village Property Taxes Important Info

Village & Kings County tax bills are issued in May (interim) and September (final).

Payment options: Online, pre-authorized payment plan, telephone banking, at your bank or in person at the village office. For online banking, search using only the word "KINGSTON". Choose KINGSTON, VILLAGE OF, NS TAXES (may vary).

The assessment account number (AAN) is the same for both the Village and the County of Kings, so be sure to choose the correct payee's name when paying online or at the bank.

Forms are available on our website or at the office for pre-authorized monthly or full amount debit payment plans.

Cash, cheque or debit only are accepted at the office (no credit card payments).
